H.M.S. COSSACK.... She brings over three hundred British seamen, rescued gr

The story of this epic of the sea will go down in history, as a Naval exploit "with the true Nelson touch".... Over three hundred British sailers (crews of sis perchant ships, sunk by the inglorious Nazi raider GRAF SHE) were herded in appalling conditions, in the bowels of the ALTMARK, a German Tanker, commanded by Captain Dahl who, by all accounts is one of the nastiest Nazis who ever sailed the seas.
