RACING IN AUSTRALIA

Fifty five thousand enthusiasts attend Randwick on Doncaster Day, there's a war on but the Australian must have his own private tussle with the bookies. Well, there's Uncle Egbert. Here's the finish of the Doncaster. As they straighten up Gold Leaf dashes to the front and looks a winner. This brilliant New Zealand 3 year old feeling the lack of racing can't hold his stablemate Mindurer. Some thought Mindurer's Newmarket victory was a fluke but the Manfred horse proves he is a great sprinter by going on to a comfortable win from Gold Leaf with the fast finishing Elderina in third place. Sensationally backed High Class was unsighted. Well ridden Munro, Mindurer was at seven-to-one - what a price - what a prize for his trainer. On Easter Monday the attendance rises to 57 thousand with the £7,000 Sydney Cup as the main attraction. Up the straight for the first time the pace is moderate and The Blizzard, Cold Spark and St. Constance are the leaders as they pass the stand followed by the favourite Yours Truly. Nearing the end of the two mile journey and now stamina tells. Yours Truly's beaten, Mosaic gets the upper hand and wins his second Sydney Cup by two lengths from Royal Chief with My Guy in third place. Another triumph for rider Darby Munro, six wins and a second in seven starts.
