

R.A.F. CLAY PIGEON SHOOTING.

Here is the latest method of training air gunners for the Royal Air Force. They use a power operated gun turret.... similar to those in the tail of many British War Planes. Only this turret is mounted on the ground.... instead of a machine gun.... the gunner uses a shot gun, and instead of enemy planes, gets to work on clay pigeons.

The target stays in the air for only 5 or 6 seconds, during that time the gunner has to aim, manipulate his turret, and fire. And they go on firing.... until the co-ordination of brain and muscle is perfect.

Its the sort of training that will bring down the Nazis in Air battles. They're teaching the R.A.F. to shoot at Birds... from every angle.
