U.S. TRAIN WRECK

On the sharpest curve of the New York Central's main line along the Mohawk River, the crack Lake Shore Limited lays a heap of buckled steel wreckage. Nine cars crashed from the rails onto the jagged rocks of the mountain. More than 200 passengers were asleep aboard the ill-fated train, the engineer died at the throttle and 29 others lost their lives. So slow is the clean-up work, the search for the dead is subordinated to caring for the injured. The Little Falls Hospital is filled to capacity with scores of victims of the New York State's worst train disaster in thirty years.
