DUKE OF WINDSOR TAKES THE OATH.

To Nassau, Capital of the Bahamas, comes the Duke of Windsor, with the Duchess, to take up his appointment as Governor General of the Islands. In the Council Chamber the Duke takes the Oath.

Later, the new Governor and his lady welcome members of the Press in the Gardens of Government House.

To the question "Do you think it in keeping with the purposes of your appointment to be referred to as goodwill Ambassador to the Western Hemisphere?" His Royal Highness replies -

"While great Britain has employed me in this role in the past, I very much doubt if the British Government has it in mind at the present that my official activities will extend beyond the confines of the Bahamas Islands".
