## U.S. DESTROYERS FOR BRITAIN.

The Anglo American Naval agreement whereby the U.S. exchanges 50 of her destroyers for a lease of British sites in the Western Atlantic, is causing much gnashing of teeth in the Axis Countries. The newly equipped Ocean greyhounds which will now fly the British flag, are as welcome to us as the Naval bases strung along the Atlantic sea-board are to America. This timely reinforcement of the Royal Navy - (which is far stronger than at the beginning of the war) results also in America's Panama Canal region gaining valuable facilities for the defence of her vital interests.

This "get together" is one of the most heartening developments of the war. With British crews aboard, the ships are racing across the Atlantic, to become another thorn in the side of Europe's gangster-in-Chief.
