2. V.S. of a group of Italian generals captured at Bidi Barani descending from RAF transport plane and being greeted by British officers at an airfield in Libya they include generals Sebastiano Gallina, Armando Pescatore and Gen. Mezzani 42
3. V.S. of the officers filling in POW uniforms and of them queuing in the open for food 40
4. V.S. m.ss. and c.us. of hundreds of Italian prisoners sitting on the sand in the prison compound, many of the prisoners are Italian Libyan colonial troops 60
