The students are submerged in a special escape chamber. Each is

wearing the Momsen lung - the equivalent of our Davis escape

apparatus - and as they leave the hatch - they follow a knotted line

attached to a marker-buey. The knots tell them when to slow up

so they won't rise too fast.

Practice trips in training submarines, beginsonly after the students have mastered the fundamentals of operation. Its a big day when they put to sea and submerge for the first time.
