HEAVY MACHINE GUNS IN ACTION.

A convey of lerries brings men of the Machine Gun Battalions of a North Country Regiment onto the ranges, for a mass exercise in concentrated fire. At the point of assembly, the gun teams prepare to show with what speed they can go into action.

Trained to perfection, they ably illustrate the high degree of proficiency attained by the modern fighting man of the British Army.

The gun teams and range-finding crews race into position as a line of 24 guns is mounted. The reserve men run forward and plant an aiming -pin in front of each gun. Now, seventy two men are ready for the order... To open-up simultaneous fire.
