

HAILE SELASSIE ENTERS ADDIS ABABA.

On the fifth anniversary of the entry of the Italian troops into the Abyssinian Capital, His Majesty Haile Selassie returns in triumph to Addis Ababa. A great ovation is given him by his subjects, who witness the moving spectacle of their Emperor attending a thanksgiving service at the Cathedral of St;George, his first act on returning to the throne of Ethiopia. Accompanied by a number of military chiefs and religious leaders (including Ras Seyun, Ras Kassa and the Chief Abbot), Haile Selassie returns thanks to Almighty God for the restoration of his country. Today, Abyssinia rejoices.

And now the triumphal procession. Headed by Ethiopian troops the Royal car makes its way to the Palace as a salute of 21 guns mingles with the greetings of the crowds thronging the tree-lined route to the Emperors home.

With his son, the Duke of Harar beside him, the Emperor calls upon his people not to reward evil with evil. "Do not shame Ethiopia"(he said, with acts worthy of our enemies". Haile Selassie has triumphed over Italy's profane

Fascist regime. Britain has set the conquering Lion of Judah once more at the head of a united Abyssinian nation, freed from the yoke of the tyrant.
