**FIRE DESTROYS WAR SUPPLIES.**

Like London under blitz is Jersey City's waterfront, as huge grain elevators, cattle pens, dock warehouses and storage buildings are laid waste by a colossal fire which rages over a quarter of a square mile. Thousands of tons of wheat and hundreds of head of cattle destined for Britain are destroyed in the blaze, which also endangers about six and a quarter million pounds worth of Defence material. Reminiscent of the Great Fire of London of September last, the inferno bears the hallmark of the worlds destroyer-in-chief.

For over six hours the wall of fire blankets the skyscrapers of New York. Throughout the night the blaze roars through thirty five acres of property, devouring everything in its path.

Agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation are suspicious that the fire which turned a score of piers and warehouses into a vast sea of flames, is attributable to sabotage.
