TEN-GUN TERROR OF THE SKIES.

Presenting our latest, and most heavily armed fighter planes - -  
 Bristol Beaufighters. Those of you who understand such things,  
 will be interested to learn that the Beaufighters twin engines are Bristol  
 Hercules air-cooled, sleeve valve radials, fitted with two-speed  
 superchargers and constant speed airscrews, each developing one-thousand-  
 four-hundred horse power. Having, I hope, satisfied at least one section  
 of my audience, I can now turn to the more easily understandable details  
 of the R.A.F.'s ten-gun terror of the skies. She is specially designed  
 for night fighting, but has already proved herself a capable day fighter.  
 Only a week or so ago Beaufighters made a very successful raid on  
 aerodromes in Sicily and accounted for 30 or 40 enemy aircraft.

The Beaufighters armament consists of four cannon mounted in the  
 fuselage and six machine guns in the wings. Ten guns; enough to blast  
any enemy machine out of the skies. She has a range of fifteen hundred  
~~miles~~ miles and a speed of three hundred and thirty miles per hour. The  
 Beaufighter will go a long way to give Goering a severe pain in his  
 Luftwaffe.
