BOOMS TO CHECK OIL FIRES.

Australian authorities try out a bright idea for confining dock-side oil fires within a limited area. If storage tanks were bombed, millions of gallons of blasing oil might flow over the water, doing untold flamage. Maritime Service Officers designed these fleating booms, with which danger spots will be enclosed in an emergency. Only a hundred gallons of old oil caused this terrific blase. Imagine what a Million gallons would do.

Sydney Fire Brigade and A.R.P. Officials conduct these tests, which prove that the booms thrown round the affected areas, hold the burning oil within bounds while the firemen go to work with a new chemical faam extinguisher.

The blaze hasn't a chance against modern science. The foam smothers the flames, and in less than three minutes we find that we must re-write the old saying "No smoke without fire", for below this great pall of smoke is just a boom-enclosed film of harmless foam.
