

LATEST PICTURES FROM THE CRIMEA.

Latest pictures from the Russian front show the arrival of big shipment of reinforcements to assist the defenders of Sebastopol. The German siege of the Russian Black Sea Naval Base is in its 6th month; but despite this, more men of the Red forces, well armed with a variety of weapons, are landing at the town harbour. A wall of Soviet artillery is continually pounding the Nazi lines.

Intense anti-aircraft barrage has proved a sure shield against air attack. Sebastopol's gunners are more than a match for Hitler's raiders who, when unable to penetrate the City's defence, bomb small villages and outlying hamlets.

We think of Sebastopol as a besieged city, but many an attack from her defenders has put the Nazis on the defensive. The key city of the Crimea knows how to hit out.
