

PREMIER BACK FROM MOSCOW.

The homecoming of our Prime Minister from his important conferences in the Middle East and Moscow. Mr. Churchill returned as he had left, in an American Liberator four engined-bomber. As he steps out of the plane wearing the uniform of an Air Commodore, Mrs. Churchill is the first to greet him, making a pleasing silhouette against the night sky. Accompanied by Air Chief Marshal Sir Charles Portal, the Prime Minister arrives in London by special train at the end of his long Journey. In just over three weeks he had travelled over 15,000 miles. On the platform, members of the Cabinet, War Office officials and Service Chiefs are there to welcome him. Notwithstanding the late hour, a huge crowd of celebrities press round him on all sides. The station black-out is momentarily broken as arc-lights and flash lamps light up the scene of another brilliant homecoming.
