The end of a seven week trip around the world. In Washington the army bomber which carried Mr. Willkie 31,000 miles, returns the much travelled emissary to an America stirred by his outspoken remarks, he says:

"Germany will never conquer Russia, but if we want to finish this war off with the minimum loss of life to American and other boys on our side of the fight, then we must get aggressive, we must get on the offensive, and the best way to get on the offensive is by opening a second front... a second front some place in Europe, not necessarily across the English Channel from England, that is the only way; The Russian front can be relieved. that is the only way by which this war can be concluded."
