(3). TITLE.:- DAVIS CUP FINALS.

Picture. :- No less than twelve thousand people were present at the ROLLAND GARROS Stadium in Paris to witness the finals for the DAVIS CUP.

This shot was taken during the Lott-Cochet match which went to the latter three sets to nil.

Monsieur Doumergue, the French President, saw the Doubles, Cochet and Brugnon versus Van Ryn and Allison.

The Americans were regarded as certain winners but Cochet the stronger of the French pair, supported Brugnon to such good effect that Van Ryn and Allison were on the defensive most of the time.

Cochet was in unbeatable form -- playing brilliant tennis.

Finally, the Match went to the Frenchmen, three sets to one -- and the DAVIS CUP remains in France for another year.
