near Brighton, they will not be--

--so close to the sea as they are now. They are backing
away--

--at the rate of 2 feet every seven days. In fact during
the last--

--storm more than ten feet disappeared in a week. The
road along the cliff top--

--is now only fifteen feet from the edge, and unless--

--immediate action is taken it will soon be too--

--dangerous to use. Work on sea defences is to be
started--

--at once, but the cliff will be vulnerable for three
months. If a--

--fierce gale attacks it during that time, the famous
cliff promenade may be eaten up.
