Sir Ronald Graham takes up the pen for Great Britain. Each plenipotentiary signs four--

--copies of the Pact - one each in the language of the signature countries. Most people agree that the object of the pact is a sincere effort towards better--

--conditions, both political and economic, but like all treaties and pacts, it has its year's and--

--its nay's. Signer Mussolini, the Italian Premier, who is also the initiator of the idea, signs for Italy. (PAUSE).

At the conclusion of the simple ceremony, huge crowds outside--

--the Palazzo Venezia are addressed by the Duce. A momentous--

--day. A bright rift in a dark political sky.
