

AIR TRAGEDY

17 DEAD IN
LINER CRASH.

The record-holding air-liner 'Southerner', flying from New York to Los Angeles, crashed in a swamp near Goodwin, Arkansas. Seventeen people were killed in the disaster. Some of them were suffocated by swamp ooze. A farmer living a mile away heard the impact, and rushed word to the nearest officials. Four women and one child were among the dead. One passenger was an oil millionaire. An impromptu inquest was held with the officials standing in three feet of swamp water. The cause of the crash is unknown. The disaster is the worst in American commercial air history.
