Neither side has ever won the supreme honours at Wembley; but Auckland --- the amateurs --- have won the Amateur Cup, and York were fresh from their conquest of mighty Blackpeol.

First blood was drawn by York City; after seven minutes, inside-left Sid Storey scored goal No. 1878

But half a minute later, Benny Edwards equalised for Auckland half -time --- one - all. 6

It was in the second half that York proved themselves the masters of the gallant amateurs; Arthur Bottom made it 2 - 15

Then Billy Hughes was brought down; 13 a penalty was awarded against Auckland.

And Bottom scored York's No. 3

So it was York City - 3 --- Bisheps Auckland - 1. And York went on into Round Five 3
