coming into dock at Tilbury is the liner Stratheden --at the end of a tragic voyage. Answering an S.O.S. the liner
went to the rescue of the Greek fishing-boat Jason off the
coast of Italy --- and the lifeboat launched from this station
capsized. Eight of the lifeboat's crew and eleven of the men
they had rescued were lost. Here are two survivors ---

Assistant Engineer Suckling and Quartermaster Rigden. ////

The sinking Jason can be seen in the background. It was on the return journey that the lifeboat capsized. The captain of the Stratheden now continues the story of that heroic endeavour in the Ionian Sea. ////
