At a dinner in London given by the English-speaking Union, Sir Anthony and Lady Eden were the guests of honour --- and the toast to them was proposed by Mr Attlee, who presided.

In his reply, Sir Anthony spoke at about reports of a change of heart in Soviet Russia.

Among the company was Mr Lewis Douglas, former United

States Ambassador to Britain and now President of the Englishspeaking Union in America. The REKER Premier went on to speak
about the work of NATO
