

~~Stirling Moss and Juan Fangio went into the lead~~ At the start of the British Grand Prix --- the race that no British driver had ever won <sup>-Stirling Moss & Juan Fangio went into the lead.</sup> This year the race --- sponsored by the Daily Telegraph --- was held on the new three-mile road course at Aintree, round the famous Grand National Steeplechase course. Twenty-four starters went hurtling round ninety laps for two hundred and seventy miles, at speeds averaging nearly ninety miles an hour. Coming into the pits and making a fast getaway is No. 28 --- the Vanwall Special driven by Ken Wharton.

Now Fangio's Mercedes has a short lead from Stirling Moss.

And now Moss --- No. 12 --- overtakes world-champion Fangio --- and it's a terrific duel between those two aces.

Victory for the British driver of the German car --- Stirling Moss is the first British driver winner of a Grand Prix at home.
