Riots in the French territories of North Africa reached a climax on the second anniversary of the deposition of the Sultan Mohammed Ben Yussef. The shack-town of Khourigba was set on fire.

At Ain-Abid, following an outbreak in which many lives were kair lost, tents were searched for the rioters and many were rounded up.

In Casablanca --- inhabitants of the danger zones were shepherded to safety areas.

But at the headquarters of the civil Control --- armed citizens were a familiar sight

Meanwhile, at Aix-Les, Bains, discussions continued between the French Government and the Grand Vizier, who is said by some to be 117 years old. France was represented by her Prime Minister and Foreign Minister.
