Juliana of the Netherlands and Prince Bernhard visited many of the
outlying villages of Dutch Guiana; and at Kadjoe in the Dutch
West Indies, the inhabitants greeted the royal travellers with a
tribal dance. On their return to the mainland, the royal
traveliers visitors were entertained by a firework display at
Government House.

JAPANESE EMPEROR.

A royal occasion in Japan. Emperor Hirohito and the Empress paid a visit to the Elizabeth Sunders Home. Public appearances of the ruling houset in Japan have become much more frequent since the Second World War. This home is an orphanage in which all the children are of mixed Japanese and western parentage.

CIVILIAN SUBMARINGE.

At Terminal Island, Los Angeles --- the launching of a submarine. And this one is defferent because it's one of the very few submarinces not attached to any Navy, Designed purely for civilian exploration of the deep, it is capable of going a mile below the surface of the sea --- and stopping below for a week.

MELBOURNE CUP.

Colossal crowds packed into Flemington Racecourse for the Australian equivalent of the Epsom Derby. It's the ninetyOfifth renewal of the Melbourne Cup. Slowed-up action shows the field bunched together in a race for £12,000 in prize money. But now they're getting cracking and as they near the end of the two-mile gallop it's seen to be a duel between two horses from New Zealand --- 6 - 1 Toporoa and the favourite, Rising Fast.

Toporoa held off the challenge to win by three-quarters of a length.
