These pictures just released by the American Defence
Department reveal shew kind of helicopter to be used by
assault units of the U.S. Marines. A twin-engined giant,
it can carry twenty-six men, fully equipped for battle.

Aven vehicles can be transported, ready for immediate action.
It is suggested that this kind of airborne force may take the
place of present-day parachute troops.

At the Smithfield Show, in London, tractors and agricultural machinery occupied two-thirds of the floor-space --- but plenty of space was also required for the livestock, which included entries from the Queen's Red Poll Herd at Sandringham. This year saw an increase in the number of pigs entered, but a slight drop in the number of sheep. As usual, the greatest number of entries were in the cattle classes; and all --- except for cross-breeds --- were from famous pedigree herds.
