

Focus of the news camera on the evacuation of Egypt and the take over by the United Nations, changes to take in the Israelis; whose victorious army was withdrawing from the Sinai Peninsula.

In order to discuss arrangements, the UN commander, General Burns, General Moshe Dayan, the Israeli Army Chief of Staff. met

Yugoslav troops took over the positions given up by Israel --- some fifteen miles inside the Sinai Desert and some thirty miles from the Canal.

At the same time, British frogmen of the Mediterranean Fleet Clearance Diving Team were still busy working on the task of clearing parts of the Canal of the wreckage sunk thereby Colonel Nasser. They were working in the absence of any kind of guarantee that blockships wouldn't become a permanent feature of the waterway between Suez and Port Said.

Here are further pictures of the continuing evacuation of British troops from Egypt. They are going aboard the Aircraft Carrier Theseus, en route for home. Britain's General Stockwell went on board Theseus to thank them for their efficient services and to wish them bon voyage.
