BEVERLEY TRANSPORT CRASH.

A Beverley transport airplane --- similar to this one recently shown at ~~the~~ Farnborough --- crashed into a house in a village some two miles from the Royal Air Force airfield at Abingdon, in Berkshire, ^{EIGHTEEN} Of the ~~seventeen~~ men on board --- mostly R.A.F. personnel --- fifteen were killed. A man and a woman were killed in the house. The Beverley had just taken off to fly to ~~the~~ Mediterranean ~~area~~.
