

Serving as a flashback reminder of the recent hostilities between Israel and Egypt, is this Israeli exhibition of some of the weapons captured by their Army in the campaigns in Sinai and Gaza. Now --- to Jordan, the present centre of Middle East tension. Changes in the Cabinet --- seen here at the Presidency Palace in Amman --- have been swift, far-reaching and bewildering. ^

In the streets of the Jordan capital there have been many of these demonstrations against what is called "the Eisenhower doctrine." The only constant factor, has been the courage of the ~~youthful~~ youthful King Hussein in a situation charged with grave dangers.

Now --- to Algiers..... to the Western shores of the Mediterranean, where France has an even more personal Middle East problem than most western Powers. French security services made a check-up in the Casbah, as the result of a tip-off on forthcoming acts of violence. Guns, knives and automatic weapons were discovered -- and, in addition, some time-bombs set to go off within a matter of minutes.
