

In London's Trafalgar Square, Associations of the Navy, the Army and the Air Force, Women's and Cadet Detachments, paraded for the annual ~~xxxxxxxxxx~~ service of commemoration of St George's Day. On the following day, the Duke had returned to Windsor Castle to accompany Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth at an inspection of the Scouts of the British Commonwealth.

With the Chief Scout, Lord Rowallan, the Queen walked over to talk to many disabled scouts who attended the annual ceremony. This year the Boy Scout movement celebrates its Golden Jubilee and also the birthday centenary of its founder, Lord Baden Powell. Watching from a window overlooking the quadrangle were Princess Margaret and Princess Anne and Prince Charles. Nearly a thousand Queen's Scouts and holders of awards for gallantry took part in the march past.

Princess Anne took part in it too. So Princess Margaret opened the window to let in more of it.

Another occasion of especial interest to the royal children, following a busy week-end ~~xxxxx~~ was an inspection of the Mounties --- a party of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police at Windsor Barracks during a goodwill visit to Britain.
