Down below in the Atlantic --- a hundred and fifty mile sm off the Azeres--- is a Boeing strate-tanker of the U.S. Air Force. Awaiting rescue from the stricken aircraft are its crew of seven. From the plane that answered their S.O.S., additional survival gear is thrown down to them.

Now all seven are safely aboard the a life-raft. Their ordeal has already lasted member four hours --- and owing to foul weather, it's not ended yet.

Actual rescue comes at the hands of x the Norwegian tanker Sanderfjord, which has also answered the call for help. All are saved --- after a total of seven anxious hours.
